- The Quote is merely an invitation by TFB to the Hirer for the Hirer to place an order with TFB.

- A request for delivery and/or installation or a direction to perform other works including variations pursuant to the Quote will be deemed to be an acceptance of the Quote, these Conditions of Supply, TFB's "Terms and Conditions" and TFB's "Credit Application – Terms and Conditions" (if applicable).

In particular, any individual may access personal information held about thim or her (subject to the permissible limitations contained in the Privacy Act 1988), and may request correction of that personal information.
